As per schedule, the Conference will begin at 9:15 a.m. on Monday Sep. 15 at the Amaldi Hall of the Marconi bldg. of the Dep. of Physics of Sapienza, University of Rome. Please look at <http://www.roma1.infn.it/conference/GPU2014/venue.html> for the way to get there.

Note that the whole Conference will be held in the Amaldi Hall .

You can pick your bag, badge and the workshop program at the Conference registration desk near to the Conference Amaldi hall on Monday Sept. 15th since 8:30am.

The coffee breaks and lunch are served to all registered participants in the terrace space of the Department at the same floor (first) of the Conference halls.
In case of bad weather, coffee breaks and lunch will be served in the "Sala Lauree" Hall, located near the aisle where the posters will be exhibited.

We will have a bus to carry people to the location of the Conference dinner.

TALKS and POSTERS

The suggested file format for the oral talks is pdf. Power point slides are good. In any case, the preferred format is the standard 4:3 format.

We suggest all the participants which plan to use their own laptop, to provide any necessary device (connectors, etc..) needed for a proper connection between the pc and the projector.

Who is carrying a poster to show can stick it on the allocated space in the nearby aisle, according to the poster number. The poster number is given following author's alphabetic order in the booklet of Abstracts.

The maximum size of the poster is the A0 standard format, i.e. 841mm x 1189mm.

The best poster, according to a selection committee, will be awarded of a Tesla K 40 GPU offered by nVIDIA.
