## TREVI FOUNTAIN and the ANCIENT WATER STREETS

September 26<sup>th</sup> (evening)





**Fontana di Trevi**, surely the most famous and spectacular fountain of Rome, built by the sculptor Gian Lorenzo Bernini in 1629, commisioned by Pope Urbano VIII. Its fame is also due to the **famous bath by night of Anita Eckberg in the movie by Federico Fellini: "La dolce Vita".** 

The Vicus Caprarius, also known as "The City of Water", is an archaeological area in the district of Trevi. This spectacular site is a recent excavation of an imperial roman quarter. The area is located 8 meters underground, in a suggestive atmosphere, and preserves the look of the activity in the center of Rome from I till V century a.D.
