The final exam consists of two parts. In the first the student discusses a topic of the course of his choice. In the second one the student is asked to present a topic of the course chosen by the exam commission.

The evaluation criteria of the exam take into account:

- the correctness of the concepts presented;
- clarity and rigor in the discussion of the in-depth presentation;
- reasoning ability on the clarification of the questions;
- the student's aptitudes to understand the choice of detectors with regard to their characteristics and the phenomena to be observed.
